- (4) Multi-disciplinary Project (MDP) for Classes III to VIII will continue to assess the Creative skills and performance of the students. *Only one MDP is to be awarded per terms for all subjects.*

- (2) Select response type questions (MCQ) — 20%.
- (3) Constructed response Questions (Short Answer/ Long Answer type Questions, as per existing pattern) = 30%.
- (4) Students will do at least one Art-Integrated Project work in each subject as part of Subject Enrichment Activity which should be trans-disciplinary in Nature.
